**RUSHCLIFFE LOCAL PLAN CONSULTATION  
GREEN BELT REVIEW CONSULTATION  
COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY CONSULTATION**

**Consultation deadline: 5pm on Friday 31 March 2017**

We are currently preparing the second part of our **Local Plan (Local Plan Part 2)**. It will include further policies and proposals for housing, Green Belt, employment, retail, open spaces, nature conservation and some other matters.

We consulted last year on what should be included in Local Plan Part 2, including where new homes might be built. We are now undertaking an additional round of consultation to consider further where new homes might be built.

The main reason for this latest consultation is because extra land may potentially be needed for housing development within Rushcliffe. This could include identifying sites for new homes at a wider range of towns and villages than was previously being considered.

A 'Further Options' document has been prepared which includes a number of questions that you may wish to use to comment on the consultation.

We are also consulting on a draft **Green Belt Review** (part 2(b)) for some extra sites. It will provide supporting information when considering possible revisions to Green Belt boundaries within the rural parts of Rushcliffe.

The **Community Infrastructure Levy** (CIL) is a levy that we can charge on new development to fund infrastructure needed to support development. As part of preparing the CIL, we have produced a CIL Preliminary Draft Charging Schedule and we are now consulting on this.
