

Dear Mr Yuille,

GOTHAM NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

In preparing for the Public Hearing on 13th June and in considering the submissions made to you, we have come to the conclusion that our consultation with the owners of the land identified as GOT5b to the south of the designated housing site GOT5a fell short of the requirements of the Neighbourhood Planning Process. We therefore ask you to rule this designation unsound and either remove Local Green Space status from these fields or request Gotham PC to remove it - whichever is more appropriate.

We apologise to you and to Rushcliffe Borough Council for this oversight. We have already apologised directly to the landowners themselves.

This failure in consultation applies to these landowners only and not to any other land designated as Local Green Space. Nor does it affect the arguments underlying the value of these fields to the village.

I have copied this letter to RBC and the landowners concerned and placed a copy on the village website.
